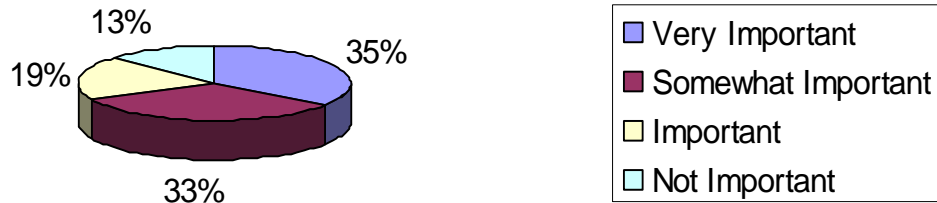

Banks Still A Trusted Source of Capital

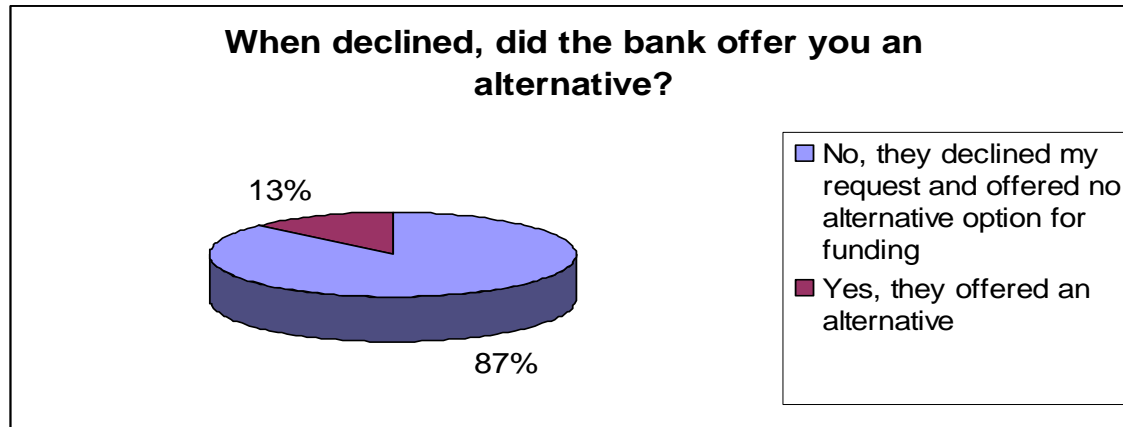
Despite the current perception that banks are struggling financially, do you still believe that banks are one of the most trusted sources of capital available to you?

Response	Percentage
Yes, and I think I could get capital from them when I need it	34%
Yes, but having an alternative/back-up source of capital is also important to me	42%
No, so I don't go to banks for capital	17%
No, but it is the only option currently available to me for working capital	7%

Any Alternatives When the Bank Says No?

Of the respondents whose bank was unable to provide the necessary working capital they applied for were asked: "Did the bank offer you an alternative?"

Response	Percentage
No, they declined my request and offered no alternative option for funding	87%
Yes, they offered an alternative	13%

Response	Percentage
